On Wednesday, August 28 the Augustana Peace Bell rang 50 times throughout the community at 12:00 noon, marking the 50th Anniversary of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King's "I Have A Dream" sermon to the nation. The previous Saturday, many of you were part of the Portland Civil Rights March and Rally that Augustana helped to sponsor as members of the Albina Ministerial Alliance Coalition for Justice and Police Reform.

Earlier in the summer, as soon as they were available, many of you began signing petitions for the Freedom to Marry and Religious Protection Ballot Initiative for November 2014. The energy and commitment you have shown to this vital cause of equality over the years has been outstanding.

In the midst of these important movements for justice, you, through our Foundation, have moved things forward for our \$15,000 High School/Jr. High Youth Room Renovation. You also came together in just a matter of days to write \$17 checks for 19 new Sunday School chairs; these are not replacement chairs, they are in addition to the many we have because our Sunday School continues to grow!

On Rally Day, Sunday, September 8 we will launch our 2013-2014 Sunday School and Christian Education season beginning outdoors during the 9:50 a.m. Sunday School hour with hundreds of us on the lawn to celebrate the oneness of all creation, and to witness to the community that we are a vital presence in this city that all are invited to be part of. On that day we will double our nursery coverage for the coming year and celebrate our intergenerational connections

and call at all four services and with an exclamation mark when we rejoice in the baptism of the Evans twins at the 11:00 service.

We will go deeper in our youth and family ministry with the arrival of Youth Ministry Intern Kristina Craig; the continued seminary internship of Norma Trimble, a Church Auction committed to our children and youth, and the re-launching of our large children's choir who will debut at our combined Cornerstone 10:00 a.m. Worship Service on Sunday, September 29 as we get to work on our several hundred new ministry endeavors.

In the midst of this we keep sisters and brothers in Syria, Egypt, Afghanistan, Iraq and our own cities in our prayers that violence and warfare may end. We also will have forums on fresh connections for good in Japan and Uganda.

How does this all go together in this multicultural, multinational, welcoming and affirming, justice seeking and peacemaking servant/sanctuary congregation? It is all part of a beautiful whole, a mosaic, a quilt of God's grace that calls us to gather in Word and Sacrament and to cheer one another on as we serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus Christ. Things have been pretty exciting here at **Well Arts**. We were pleased to play temporary hosts to MP Kelly Vincent, the youngest woman voted to Australian Parliament, and also the first MP to rely on a wheelchair to get around. MP Vincent is also a playwright with No Strings Attached and she was keen to learn about artists working in healing contexts here in the states. This year, Well Arts is creating playwriting workshops and original performances, partnering with Northwest Down Syndrome Association, the National MS Society: Oregon, National Alliance on Mental Illness Washington County, the Urban League of Portland's Senior Multicultural Center, the Delta Sigma to work with parents of children with disabilities, the National MS Society: Oregon to work with people living with MS, the Portland Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. June Key Delta Community Center, Portland Vet Center and the Pettygrove Boys and Girls Aid Society. We will be telling stories with parents of children with disabilities, adults living with MS, mental illness, veterans with PTSD, girls ages 14-18 in the juvenile justice system, and capping the season off with a performance of intergenerational, oral history stories from local African American women. To get us warmed up and ready for all this work, Well Arts partnered with the University of Oregon and Good Samaritan Health Services in Corvallis to create the first annual Pacific Northwest Arts in Health Symposium, at the White Stag building August 23-24th. We're so grateful for the support from Augustana Lutheran Church, that makes this all happen. Thank you so much for giving us a home.

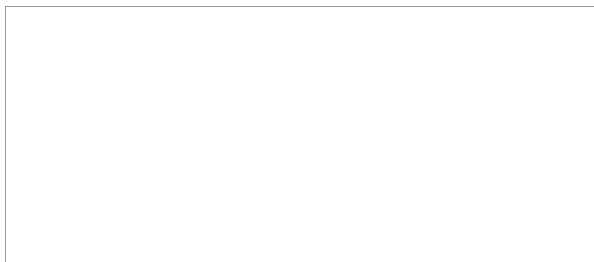
